4.3.2: Specific Learning Resources

Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Library plays a vital role in the collection, development and dissemination of medical, scientific and technical information to meet the present and future needs of the departments of the Institute. The aim of college central library is to become an instrument of information and an integral part of teaching program. Thus the basic function of the library is to assist every department to carry its program and adequately serve the information needs and requirements of the Faculty members, Research Scholars, Postgraduates and Undergraduates. All the members can make full use of its resources and services. Library provides the following e-resources like **ERMED Consortium** NML, DGHS, MoHFW Govt. of India, New Delhi having 235 + e-journals of 5 publications (British Medical Journal, Cambridge University Press, Lippencott W W, Wolter Kluwer, Oxford University Press and Wiley-Blackwell), **Cochrane Library**; **UPTODATE**- Evidence-based clinical decision support, **DELNET** (Developing Library Network, New Delhi) (Membership) of full text digital library resource includes 375 e-books, 2224 medical e-journals. Library has subscribed 18649 print National and International Journals and 5247 online journals and 33 national online free journals as well as 31185 books out of that 10529 are textbooks and 20656 are reference books, 416 full text e-books and 6429 donated books. Library provides e-material to the registered users by KOHA software with the help of OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) system through HIS (Hospital Information) system. In **OPAC homepage** system: Online databases- the National Medical Library, D.G.H.S. New Delhi facilitated 239+ high impact e-journals (International) through ERMED Consortium under single gateway. In addition, the library has subscribed to digital resources like Uptodate.com & DELNET library consortium & 2074 e-resources of the digital library of **Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik**. In e-resource option: e-books, dictionaries, e- Newspaper directory facility are given. Question papers of Undergraduates and Postgraduates arranged by subject wise and year wise. 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Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences believes in fostering self-directed learning and therefore has ensured that a befitting ambience and adequate facilities are available in its main library, Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Library. It provides a comprehensive collection of resources in print versions as well as in the form of e-repository. Library has collection of 31185 books that include 10529 textbooks and 20656 reference books. In the last 5 years from 2017-22, 1214 books and 1468 reference books have been acquired.

The thesis/dissertation of the PG/ PhD/ are curated regularly; currently 1251 numbers are available, out of which 218 have been added over the last 5 years.

To enable literature search for researches, the library consists of 5247 titles of national and International Journals that are peer-reviewed and indexed in reputed databases. The back volumes are hardbound and properly catalogued for easy retrieval. A total collection of 18515 back volumes journals are available, out of which 895 numbers were added over the last 5 years.

E-resources such as ERMED, DELNET and e-ShodhSindhu provide access to 15247 e- journals.
