Antarchakshu® — The Eye Within, conceptualized by the Xavier's Resource Centre for the Visually Challenged XRCVC, is an experiential workshop aimed at creating a sneak preview for the sighted into the world of persons with disabilities in general and blindness and low vision in particular. It is a simulated environment where participants, through experiencing a disability simulation, will learn to reflect on personal attitudes towards persons with disabilities. This simulation is then followed by an interactive session. The objective of the workshop is to equip its participants with insight, understanding and basic facts about the lives of the visually impaired, the 'How?' of their lives, as also to foster an insight in developing their own perspective on the issue. Antarchakshu® serves the dual aim of not only sensitizing participants to disability but serves as a potent tool towards personal growth and motivation.

Krishna Warriar has over 30 years' experience in Journalism and Communications Skills. After his career in journalism he has been working in the area of disability awareness. He has held senior editorial positions in Reader's Digest, Hindustan Times, Mid-day, and Centre for Monitoring the Indian Economy (CMIE). REPORT

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of MGIMS Sevagram is organizing an online workshop in collaboration with the Centre for Enquiry into Health and Allied Themes (CEHAT). In this introductory workshop, we will look at "Why gender matters in medical education and health care."

Since 2015, CEHAT, in collaboration with DMER, MUHS and UNFPA, has made efforts in integrating gender in medical education (GME). Building on their work in Maharashtra, their ongoing project aims to engage medical educators across India to integrate gender concerns in UG course (MBBS) so as to reduce health inequities and recognise social dimensions related to health risks, health seeking behaviour and health outcomes. It also aims to integrate gender concerns by building a cadre of gender informed medical educators across India to facilitate gender perspective in UG curricula and collaborate to remove harmful medical practices.

The workshop will be held on Saturday, 12 February 2022 between 2-4 pm in an interactive online format. We are targeting the medical teacher to see how we can make a difference. Please feel free to circulate this brochure to all medical teachers in other medical colleges, as well.


On February 12, 2022, Centre for Enquiry into Health and Allied Themes (CEHAT) along with the Internal Quality and Assurance Cell (IQAC) at Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences (MGIMS), Sevagram conducted an online workshop on WHY GENDER MATTERS IN MEDICAL EDUCATION AND HEALTHCARE. Seventy-five faculty and medical education unit members from medical and nursing colleges across India attended the two-hour workshop.

The opening session was facilitated by Dr. Renu Khanna (Society for Health Alternatives-SAHAJ, Vadodara), engaging participants in an interesting discussion on sex and gender. Participants were asked to think through some statements and identify if the differences were based on sex or gender. Dr. Khanna introduced participants to gender as a system and concepts of intersectionality. The session also threw light on how gender interacts with health and healthcare seeking, differentially impacting men, women and transgender persons. This was explained with the help of examples about respiratory illnesses, road traffic accidents and gender-based violence.

The following session, facilitated by Sangeeta Rege and Amruta Bavadekar from CEHAT, detailed the journey of our Gender in Medical Education (GME) project in Maharashtra. Participants were informed about the conceptualisation of this project, medical educators' perceptions towards gender integration, and CEHAT's gender-integrated modules for five disciplines- general medicine, community medicine, obstetrics/gynaecology, forensic medicine and toxicology and psychiatry. A short film on GME was shown explaining how CEHAT used innovative pedagogy to integrate gender concerns in medical education without adding to the burden of medical educators. We used excerpts from our assessment study to explain how our project interventions effected positive change in medical students' gender-related attitude and practices.

The final session emphasised on the need for gender-sensitivity in clinical practices and the means to this end. The session was facilitated by Dr. Shrinivas Gadappa (Professor and Head, Department of Ob/Gyn, GMC Aurangabad) who underwent gender-training under CEHAT's GME project in Maharashtra. Dr. Gadappa spoke about how the training helped him and other educators incorporate a gender lens, not only in medical education but also in clinical practice. Dr. Gadappa spoke of the various initiatives he led in GMC Aurangabad, including gender-sensitive labour room practices and setting up breastfeeding booths (*hirkani kakshas*) in OPDs. He also shared that the training helped him undertake various research studies and present them nationally and internationally.

Participants' feedback highlighted that they appreciated the interactive nature of workshop, discussions around sex and gender, content shared by the speakers and examples of how gender-concerns were implemented in clinical practice.



REPORT

Rheumatology is the science of rheumatic diseases, affecting articulo-periarticulo-muscular structures (loco-motor system) and other connective tissues of the human body (systemic diseases), characterised by pain, swelling, stiffness and limitation in the joints, with other systemic symptoms and signs. There are a large number of rheumatic diseases or arthritis, little over 100 in number, known from ancient times all over the world.

As it is one of the most rapidly evolving and growing branches in medicine, knowledge about rheumatology and related diseases is inevitable for a physician. Considering its significance, Department of Medicine MGIMS, Sevagram, organised a CME on Rheumatology on 28th March 2022. It was organised by Dr Bharati Taksande, professor of medicine Mgims Sevagram.

The event was organised in SN Hall, MGIMS, Sevagram .The guest speaker for the event was Dr Rajiv Gupta. He is current head of Medanta's Division of Rheumatology and Clinical Immunology. Dr. Rajiv Gupta completed his higher training in the UK where he became a member of Royal College of Physicians. He has completed his senior residency in rheumatology & clinical immunology from All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi and MD in Internal Medicine from Maulana Azad Medical College, Delhi. He is also a fellow of Royal College of Physicians in Glasgow and Edinburgh respectively and has been a highly respected member of over 15 international and national medical associations and forums. The programme started with Dr Rajeev Gupta's talk on approach to arthritis. He has explained right from the basics of rheumatology to the most modern treatment options. It was followed by open discussion of cases of autoimmune diseases with Dr Shivani Shukla, and Dr Saiprasath, Junior residents from medicine to Dr Rajeev Gupta. The case discussion was very much informative for the whole audience. Residents from Dermatology also presented a case of systemic scleroderma to Dr Rajeev. We all got to know small little things which we miss in a diagnosis and how to differentiate various autoimmune diseases from each other if they have overlapping clinical features.

It was followed by an enlightening talk by Dr Nitin Gangane, Dean of MGIMS and an eminent pathologist, on immunopathogenesis in Rheumatology. It was followed by Lunch. Post lunch sessions began with Dr Sumit Kar, Head of dermatology department of MGIMS, on dermatological manifestations in rheumatology.

It was followed by Dr Pooja Sharma's speech on clinical trials in rheumatology. At last but not the least, Dr C.M. Badole sir, professor and head of department of Orthopedics talked about surgical options in management of rheumatoid arthritis.

The event was a big success as it gave the residents as well as the faculty an opportunity to learn from the most experienced teachers. More over , presence of Dr OP Gupta and Dr A P Jain, Emeritus professors of medicine in MGIMS, Dr Jyoti Jain, Head of Department of Medicine, MGIMS was a cherry on the cake.

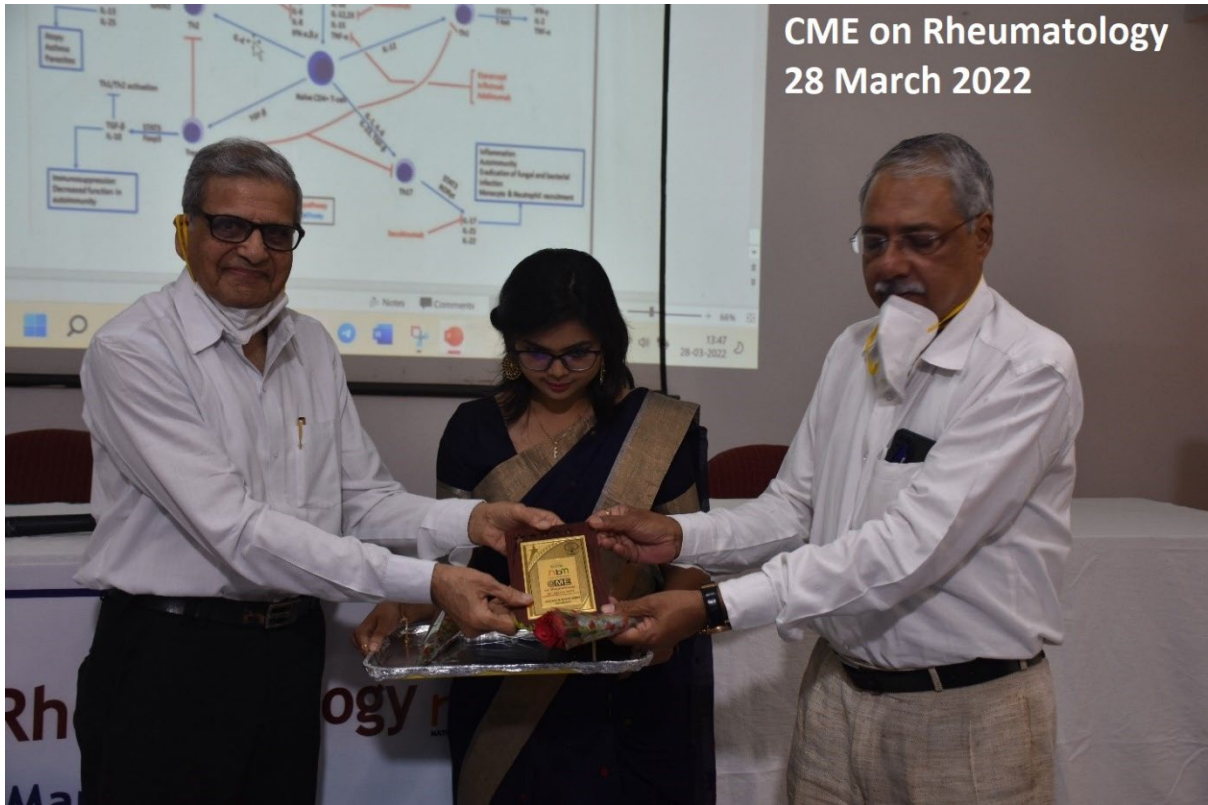




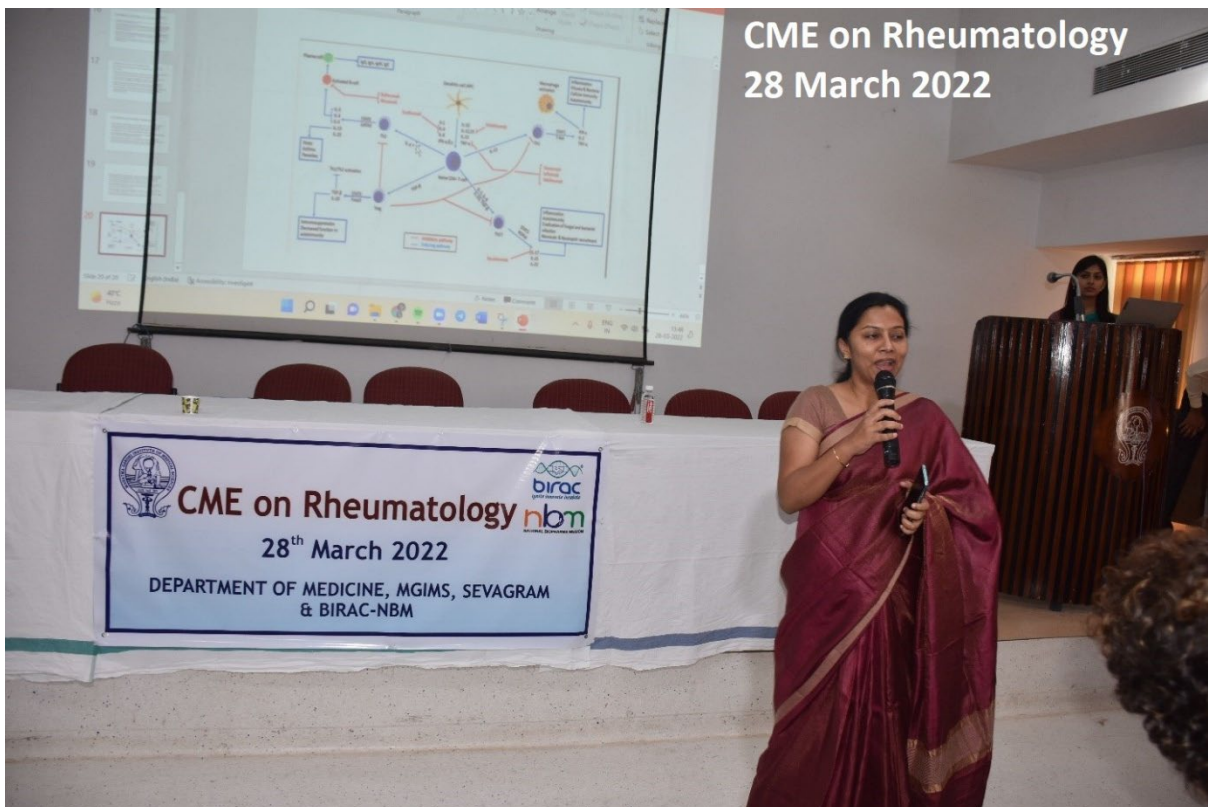

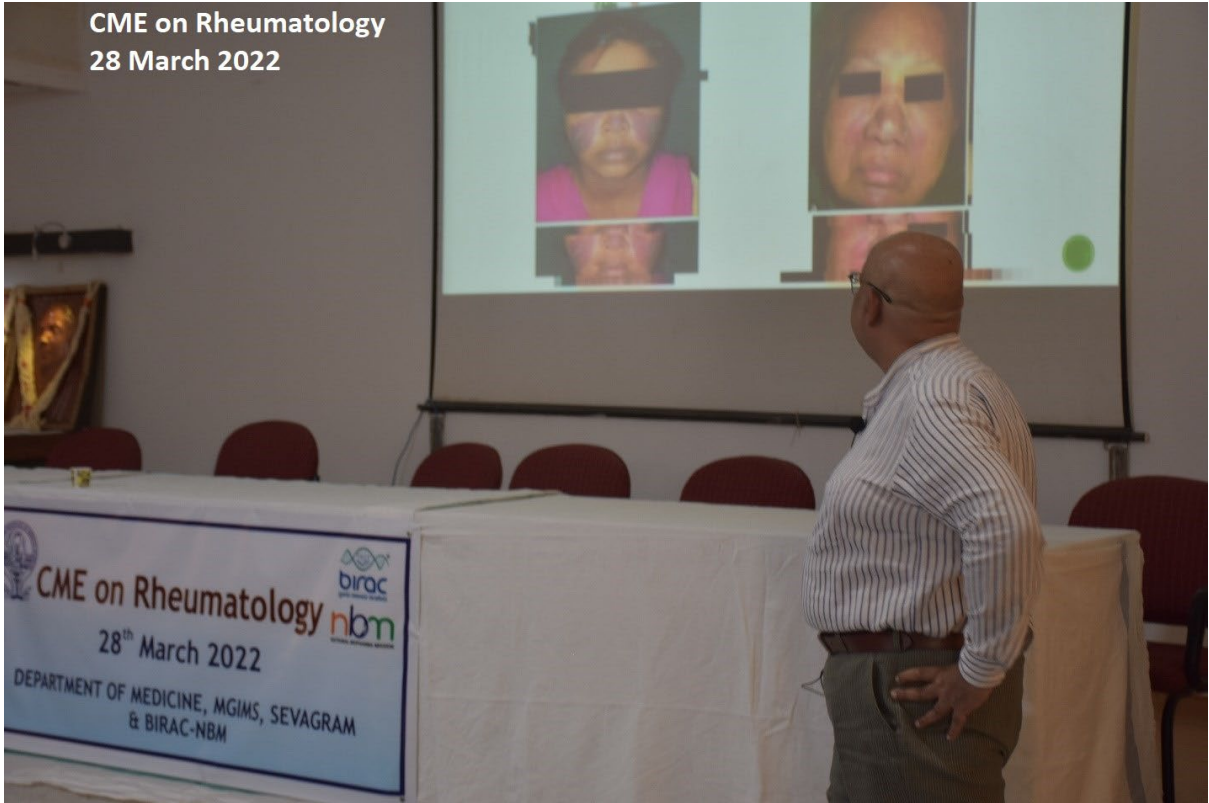
