On 24th July 2018, the Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Library was inaugurated and made functional in the new premises with well-equipped furniture with cost of Rs. 74,08,830. Thirty new computers were added at a cost of Rs. 14,33,700. The library has free wi-fi Internet section with a fast broadband service of high speed 1GBPS. Implementation of Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) is used in library for managing the automated library and also for theft detection with cost of Rs1466349.
