Action taken report on Feedback reports 2022

1. The IQAC Coordinator reported that the Stakeholder Feedback Analysis on the Curriculum, infrastructure and teaching-learning-assessment process to the Dean on 23 March 2022.
2. This analysis was discussed in the College Council on 26 March 2022.
3. The Dean informed that the student feedback will be discussed with individual HODs. He requested that the HODs should also discuss it with faculty members and departmental meeting. He informed that the staff and faculty feedback will be discussed with management at earliest.
4. The feedback analysis with the AQAR was presented in the Local Managing Committee Meeting of Kasturba Health Society subsequently
5. Based on the feedback, the curriculum committee decided to make several changes in its approach. Subcommittees were formed in accordance with NMC guidelines in view of the new competency-based curriculum. CISP workshops and Revised Basic Course workshops were planned.
6. There were discussions with individual heads of departments by the Dean and their performance was discussed in terms of academics and faculty development. Each department was asked to record their plans of action
7. All departments planned their elective modules in view of the upcoming electives for 2019 batch
8. The MEU and IQAC were asked to conduct faculty development programmes on assessment, e-learning, IPR and gender sensitivity
9. The IQAC and MEU conducted a Workshop on SNACS/ SNAPS approach for remedial teaching and improvement of academic performance of low achievers
10. The guidelines for improvement were circulated to all faculty by IQAC
